The New Zealand Institute of International Affairs (NZIIA) - Whare Tawāhi-a-mahi i Aotearoa, is an independent, non-governmental organisation that fosters expert discussion and understanding of international affairs. It exists for the long-term political, social, economic and environmental wellbeing of Aotearoa New Zealand.

The Institute delivers over 80 public events across New Zealand annually, including a national conference, along with research and analysis, communications and six editions of its flagship magazine publication New Zealand International Review.

NZIIA is a registered charitable society governed by an eight person Board. It comprises a National Office (based in Wellington) and seven branches around New Zealand: in Christchurch, Nelson, Wellington, Wairarapa, Palmerston North, Hawkes Bay and Auckland.
